

(76) *Al-Insan: The Human*

In the Name of Allah The All Merciful, The Most Merciful.

1. Has it come upon the human a while of time he was not a thing mentioned?
2. Assuredly We created the human from a distillate mingled (so) We test him, then We made him hearing, sighted.
3. Assuredly We guided him (to) the way, either he is thankful or repudiating.
4. Assuredly We prepared for the repudiators chains and shackles and blaze.
5. Assuredly the dutiful drink from a goblet, its blend was (from) Camphor...
6. ...a spring. Drink from it do the slaves of Allah; they burst it, bursting!
7. They fulfill the vow and they fear a day whose evil is ever flying out.
8. And they feed the food, despite love of it, to a needy (person), an orphan, and a captive.
9. "In fact, we feed you for the Countenance of Allah, we want not from you recompense nor thanks."
10. "Assuredly we fear from our Lord a day grimacing, intense."
11. So shielded them did Allah from the evil of that day, and delivered (to) them radiance and joy.
12. And He recompensed them, for being patient, (with) a Garden and silk.
13. Reclining in it on divans, they see not in it sun nor frigidness.
14. And lowered upon them are its shades, and subjugated are its crops, subjugating!
15. And circulating among them (are ones) with vessels of silver, and cups that are ever glassware.
16. Glassware of silver, they value it, valuing!
17. And they are hydrated in it, a goblet whose blend is ginger.
18. A spring is in it named Salsabeel.
19. And circulate among them do eternal children; when you see them you count them as scattered pearls.
20. And when you see there, you see comforts and great dominion.
21. Upon them are clothes, fine green silk and brocade, and they are adorned with bracelets of silver; and their Lord hydrated them, (with) a purified drink.
22. Assuredly this is to you recompense, and your pursuit is ever thanked.
23. Assuredly it is We who descended upon you the Qur'an, descending!
24. So be patient with the judgment of your Lord, and obey not from them a wicked one nor a repudiator.

25. And remember the name of your Lord, early morning and late afternoon.

26. And from the night, prostrate to Him and extol Him, a long night.

27. Assuredly those love The Haste and they leave behind them a heavy day.

28. We created them and invigorated their sinew and, if We will, We substitute similar to them, substituting!

29. Assuredly this is a reminder, so whoever wills would take to his Lord a way.

30. And you do not will except that Allah wills, assuredly Allah is ever most knowledgeable, most judicious.

31. He enters whoever He wills into His mercy; and the oppressors, He has prepared for them painful torment.
